Fees Information Booklet 2017

There are a number of charges that should be paid by students attending Marcellin College. Accounts are sent out at the start of each year and then each month by email or post. Account balances are available on the Kamar Parents Portal.

We ask that you establish a regular payment from the start of 2017.

Where a student commences a term, the attendance dues and financial contributions will be asked for the full term, even if the student should leave during the term.

Attendance Dues (Compulsory)

Attendance Dues are approved by the Minister of Education under Section 36 of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975. Payment of Attendance dues is a legal requirement and condition of enrolment at an integrated school. Attendance Dues are used to help to pay the costs associated with the land and buildings at Marcellin College. Attendance Dues are collected on behalf of the school's proprietor Marcellin College Limited.

All parents and caregivers with children at Catholic integrated schools are required to pay their Attendance Dues. In order that no child should be denied a Catholic Education because of family financial hardship, assistance may be granted. To arrange for such assistance, you should contact the Accounts Manager-Morganne Sale or School Principal-Jan Waelen.

Assistance is not available for non-preference students at Marcellin College.

Years 9 to 13 \$824 per year (\$206 per term)

Financial Contributions

2017 Contributions for Year 7-13 are \$320 per student

Below outlines what the contributions consist of:

Board of Trustees General Purpose Contribution-\$150

This contribution to the Board of Trustees is used to benefit all students in and outside the classroom. The funds are used for developing religious, educational, cultural, sporting, and computer facilities school-wide, as well as the provision of other equipment and activities as approved by the Board of Trustees.

Catholic Special Character Contribution-\$50

The contribution provides the main source of funding for all services provided by the Catholic Education Services Board. It is vitally important to fund the preservation and enhancement of Catholic Special Character of the school.

ICT Upgrade Fund Contribution-\$50

The ICT contribution is used to fund the much needed upgrade of the college's ICT network that is required to provide essential resources for students.

Proprietor Contribution-\$20

The Proprietor Contribution is to assist with the maintenance of the Chapel and other non-integrated buildings of the College which are made available by all students at the College. It will also go towards the development of improved facilities.

PTFA Contribution-\$20

The Parent Teachers Friends Association contribution is an annual charge that is forwarded to the committee which has its aims to promote goodwill, fund raise and encourage co-operation in all aspects of the College life.

School Yearbook-\$30

The annual school yearbook includes photos and articles written by students.

All contributions, except for the school yearbook, attendance dues, subject and sport charges qualify for a tax rebate and a tax donation receipt will be issued automatically in April by email or post.

Additional Charges

Sports Charges (Compulsory)

All students who participate in a School Sports Team are required to pay a charge. This covers entry fees with sporting associations, uniform hire and laundry, purchase of equipment and referee costs. This charge will be added to your account for payment.

Year 7 to 13 \$20 per student per sport code

(Maximum of three sport codes will be charged= \$60)

Other Charges

Additional charges are made for school/class trips and camps. Parents will be given notice of these by the relevant staff member(s) during the year.

Subject Charges (Compulsory)

Some subjects will incur costs for the year, with only those students doing the subject(s) having to pay these costs. These subject costs are either for equipment / materials / stationary (which students use to create articles which are taken home), or for homework books (which students write notes or does exercises). Once subjects are confirmed in Term 1, we ask that parents please make payment immediately for subject so your child is fully equipped in their subject(s).
